
Dr. Iain McCall Receives Honorary RSNA Membership



During the Annual Meeting of the Radiological Society of North America (RSNA) Dr. Iain McCall and two other individuals, all who have been distinguished as outstanding contributors to the field of radiology and its allied sciences, were awarded honorary RSNA memberships.
