He serves as Director of the General ICU of the Dept of Anesthesiology and Intensive Care Medicine at Policlinico A. Gemelli University Hospital and Director of the School of Specialty in Anesthesiology and Intensive Care Medicine.

Prof. Antonelli served as Editor in Chief of Intensive Care Medicine from 2007 to 2013. Associate Editor of the same Journal from 2000 to 2007. He is Past President of the Italian Society of Anaesthesiology and Intensive Care Medicine (SIAARTI).

He is the author of more than 300 papers with more than 10000 citations, H index 55. The majority of these scientific publications are on several aspects of Noninvasive Ventilation, ARDS, Shock and sepsis. He has also been an invited lecturer or chairman in more than 500 International Meetings.
